# CSS Specificity Rules

---

- ❖ Determines which CSS rule is applied by the browsers

---

# Specificity Rules

---

- ❖ Unique rules are compounded for an element
- ❖ Last rule overrides previous and conflicting rules
- ❖ Most specific selector overrides least specific selector
  - ❖ Specificity Order: ID > Class > Element
  - ❖ Example: `div { color: blue; }` vs. `.warn { color: red; }`
- ❖ Inline style overrides all the other rules
- ❖ **!important** cannot be overridden (NOT recommended)
